Granola bars, protein bars

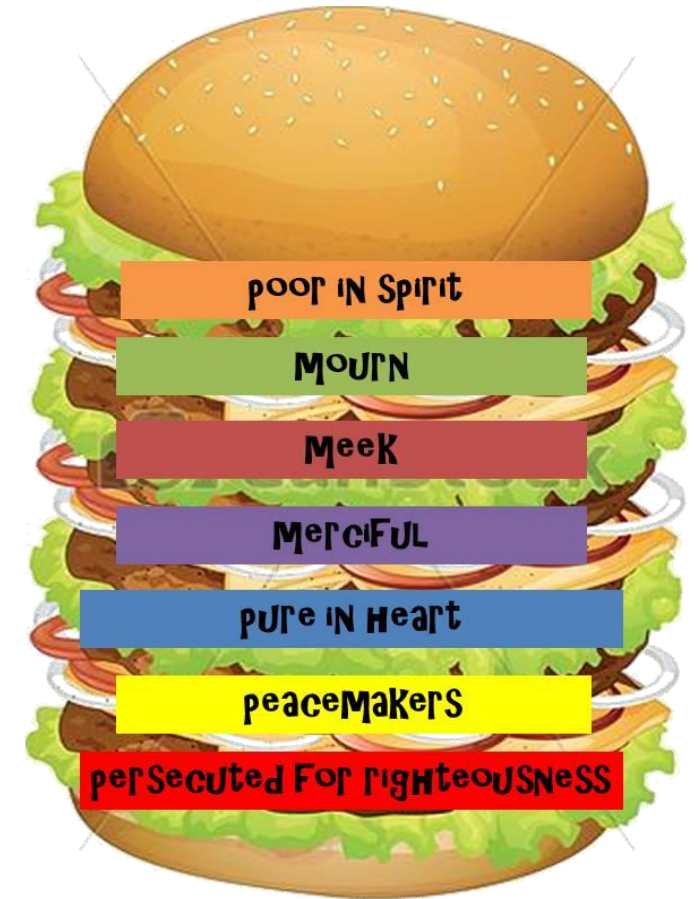
