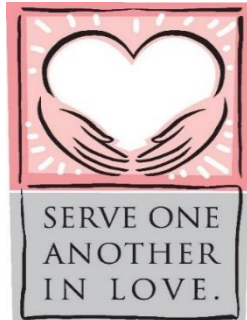

Coalition Against Poverty in Suffolk (CAPS) for distribution. Each bag contained toiletries as well as other miscellaneous items.

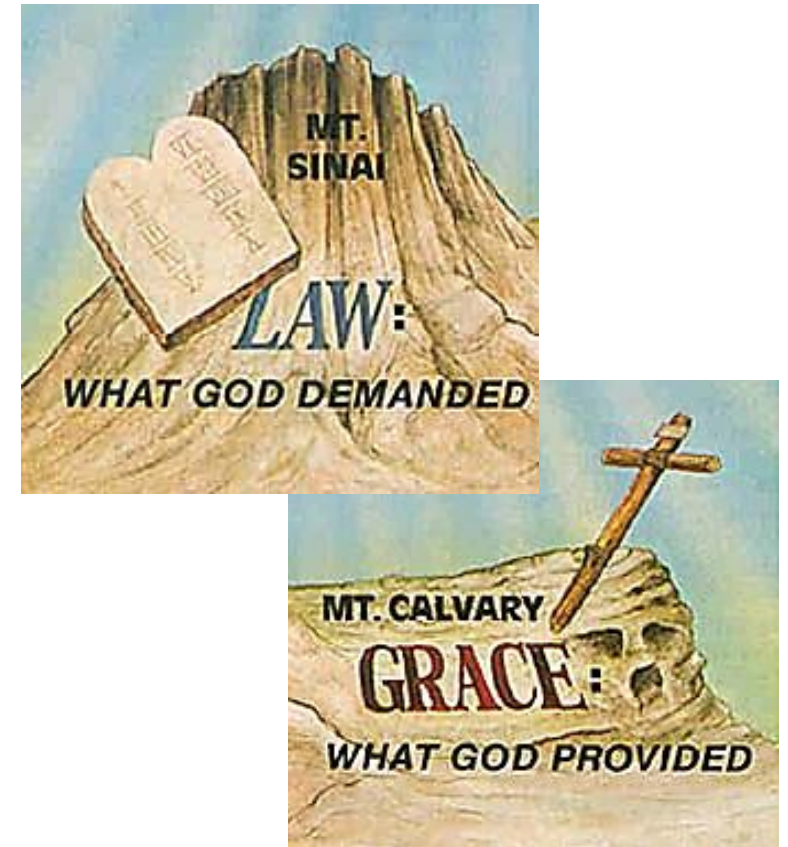
Additionally 6 large bags of various items were given to CAPS so that they could be combined with items in their stock to create more gift bags for the homeless.
